YWAM RUSTENBURG VISION

The vision of YWAM Rustenburg is to make a difference by releasing the kingdom of God on the earth in greater measure. As a ministry we have several focuses that include:

Training & Equipping

Our Discipleship Training School is nine-month program designed to empower and equip the saints of God. This is done in a three-fold manner:

1. Basic Bible Training

The first few months of the DTS are spent laying a solid Biblical foundation through teachings on subjects like salvation, baptism, how to study the Word, spiritual warfare, authority, spiritual disciplines etc. Students are taught how to preach and give testimonies and are given opportunities to teach the material they have learned in various settings. The practical side of ministry is very important to us. Students will not only learn a subject in a classroom but will also be given opportunities to put these things into practice on the field e.g. the week that students are taught on communion and water baptism, they will be taken into village churches, local cell groups and home fellowships to teach the people what they have learned. They will then lead people in the taking of the bread and wine and personally baptize the people in water.

It has been said that people learn five times faster through practical experience than simply through hearing something repetitively and so most of what we do on the school will have practical elements to it.

2. Wholeness & Holiness

Five-fold ministers are called to equip the saints for work of service (Ephesians 4:11). The word equip in the Greek comes from the root word Katartizo, meaning

- to mend
- to repair
- to fix

We recognize that emotional wounds and scars can often hinder the equipping progress and affect areas of our character. A strong emphasis is placed on helping students work through the “stuff” in their lives that hinder the production of the fruit of the Spirit as well as the flow of their spiritual gifts.

Character is vital. Integrity, honor and love are qualities that are earnestly nurtured in the lives of our students.

3. Spiritual & Natural gifts

Through the DTS we help students to discover and develop both the natural and spiritual gifts that God has placed within them. Students will learn what it means to live from the Kingdom of God instead of working for it. Students will learn to heal the sick, cast out demons and prophesy. They will learn how to hear the voice of God and come into a much greater understanding of the Spirit realm.

Students get to practice their gifting when ministering to the lost through street evangelism, door-to-doors, crusades, church services, cell groups, sporting events, service projects, and various other ministry opportunities.

Community Development & Outreach

Currently we have two feeding schemes where we feed around 100 children a warm meal every weekday. One location is an after-care facility for the orphans where they play games, eat a warm meal and receive spiritual oversight. Although the after-care centre is not complete, our vision is to set up children’s jungle gyms, swings and basketball hoops. One room of the centre will get laptops where the students will do various educational activities and learn how to use computers. As a ministry we help to provide school clothes and stationery, clothes, blankets, mattresses and have helped to put water and electricity into some of the orphans homes. The current plan is that the centre will also have a preschool running so that we can care for the children while the single parents can seek employment.

Upon completion of this centre, we hope to duplicate centres around the various villages in Phokeng.

Our desire as a ministry is to reach into every sphere of society whether that is in government, business, the streets, the homeless, prostitutes, drug addicts, orphans and widows, etc. We hope that in the coming years we will have missionaries who will join YWAM Rustenburg to minister in these areas. As missionaries come in with a vision to reach into these areas, we as a ministry will assist the missionary in the area they feel called through arranging training, providing accountability and sending missions teams to support.





Staff Equipping

We encourage our staff to continue to pursue further training in the areas of their passions and giftings. Various training and equipping sessions are held with staff on various occasions to ensure that they are growing in their own giftings and abilities as leaders, families and ministers.

Character Development

As a ministry we place enormous emphasis on character. Outside of our everyday struggles with conflict or financial difficulties, we believe that God develops our characters through the environment He places us in and uses the personalities, giftings, strengths and weaknesses of those He surrounds us with to sharpen us. “As iron sharpens irons, so one man sharpens another” (Proverbs 27:17).

The leadership of YWAM Rustenburg strives to mentor and empower their staff as best possible through correction, rebuke, confrontation, accountability, friendship and teaching. We believe it vital that our character should grow together with our gifting and that ministry is not just on some mission field or in the church but that it's important that we are examples in every area of life ranging from how we handle our finances to how we raise our children.

Community-focused

As a ministry we are called to be a community-focused base. Staff are encouraged to make every effort to be involved in our local community in some way or another. Relationships with people in our community are not only beneficial for our community but for us as a ministry as well.

A Gateway for Missionaries

There are many people in the world today who desire to be in missions but are not sure where to start or how to get into it. We would like to provide opportunities for people to come and try missions for themselves in a safe and nurturing missions environment.

A Base of Intimacy & Power

1 Corinthians 4:20 says the, “The kingdom of God does not consist in word, but in power.” Our ministry is not so much what we speak but rather how we live. As a ministry we strive for deeper intimacy with God as well as for manifestations of the Spirit of God that result in salvation, miracles, healings and the casting out of demons. We work in environments where the demonic realm is a very real and a regular experience for many and the only way to be effective in our ministries in these environments is through the power of God.

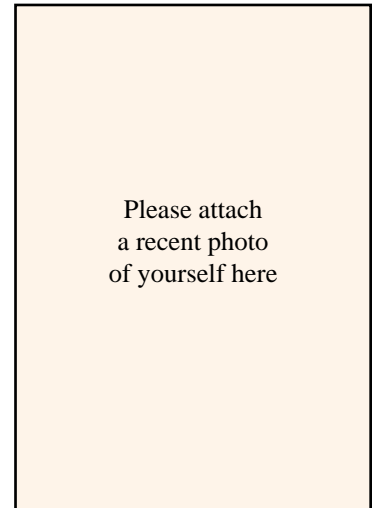
